Their power to connect provides our residents, local institutions, businesses and nonprofit organizations a safe space to share ideas, find solutions to difficult problems and to access vital resources. That heroism continues today through a recent pilot program in partnership with our Department of Health's Gun Violence Intervention Team to distribute gun locks at library

Their power to educate is evident in the multitude of information and resources that allow our families to explore new topics, and learn new skills. We see that power through the Kindergarten

Readiness Program hard at work in our communities addressing the disparities in opportunity and progress that come from children not being prepared to enter school.







- allows the enlarged images and text to be viewed by all,
- helps increase vocabulary, attention and reading comprehension and
- encourages interactive play, where children can have "magic fingers" as they turn the page or highlight a word with their touch.


